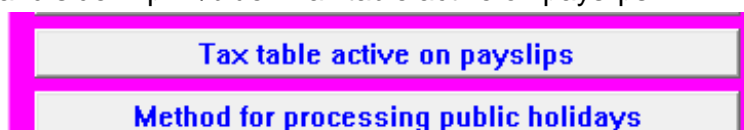
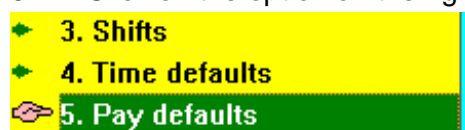


TAX TABLES ACTIVE ON PAYSLEIPS

When using the AfriClock Payroll, PAYE will be calculated according to South African (or Namibian) tax tables.

Should you desire not to use the South African tax tables, the default system setting with regards to this, must be changed, as follows:

1. Click on the Main Screen on: Tables.
2. Click on Nr. 5 in the yellow block: Pay defaults.
3. Click on the option on the right hand side in pink/blue: Tax table active on payslips.



4. Select the company applicable (if more than one).
5. Click on: OK.
6. A screen will open where you can choose if South African tax tables should be used:
